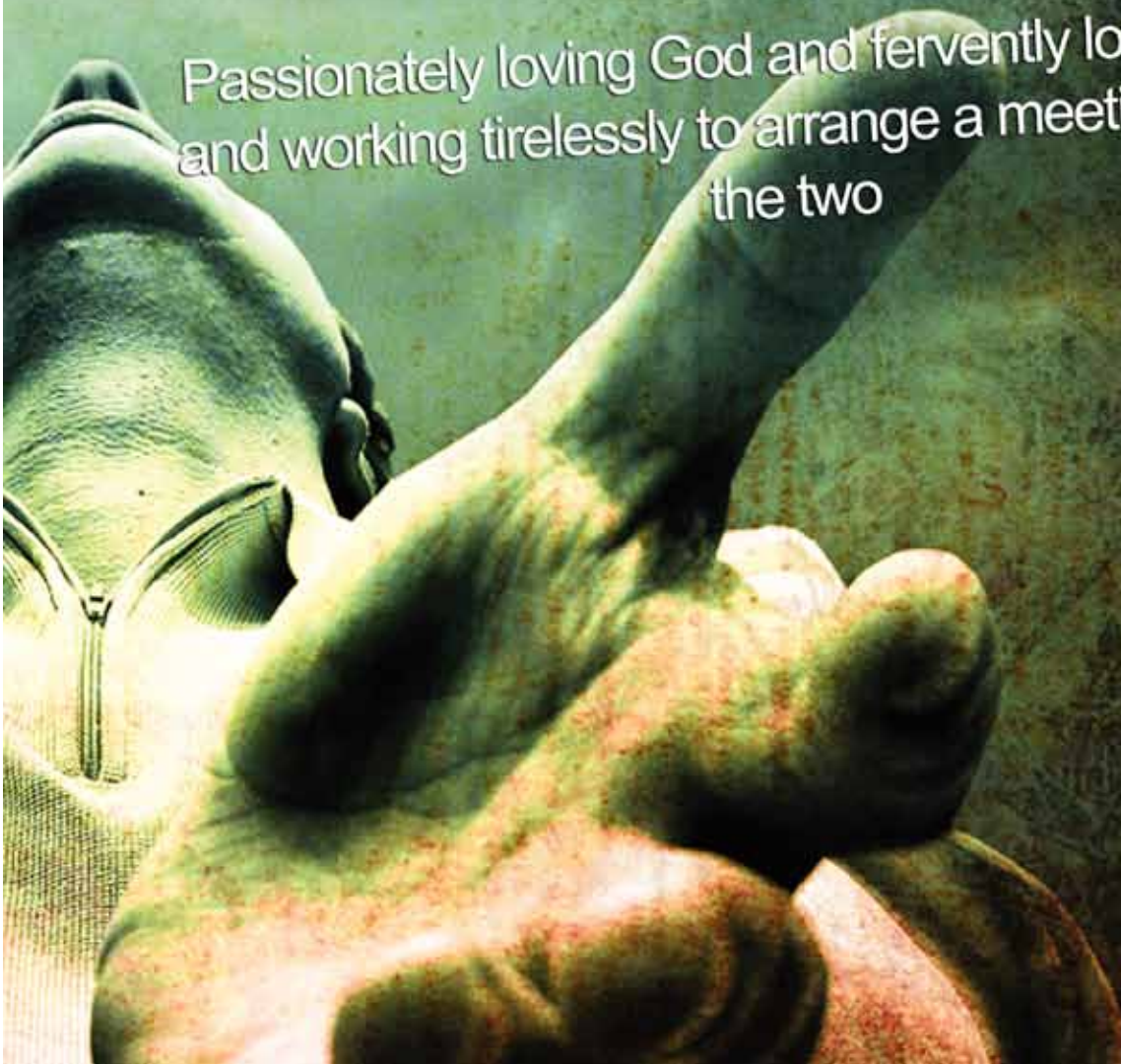

Salvations to Baptism Ratio 45%

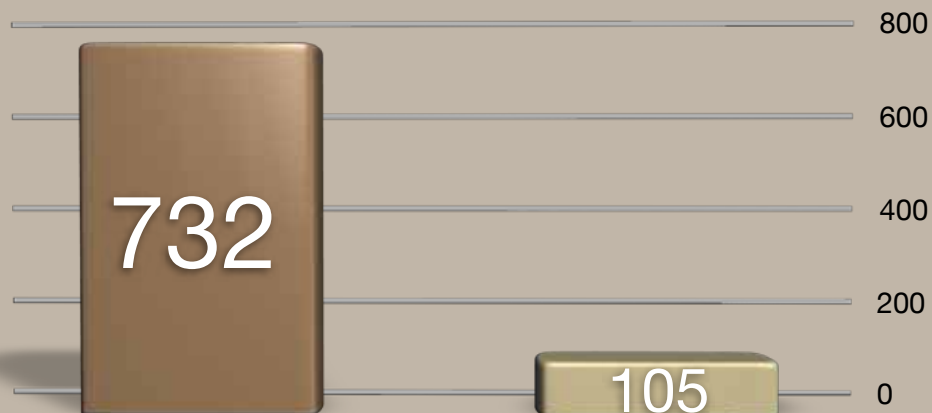
BAPTISMS

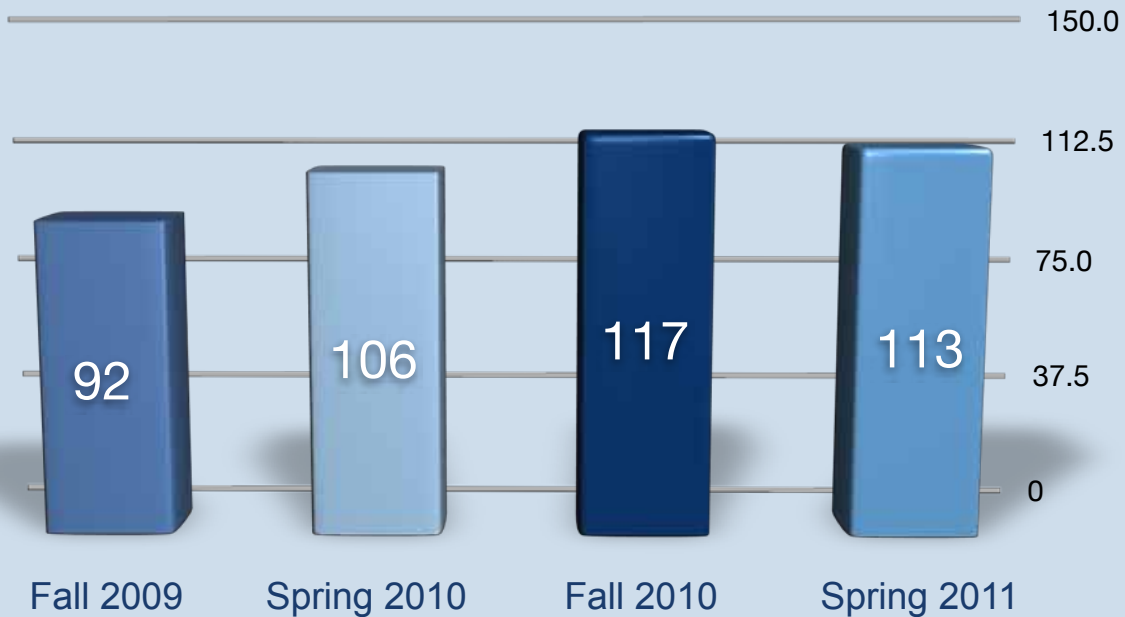

From 2008 to 2010 going into 2011 we have seen a rapid growth not only in the number of our lifegroups, but mainly in the number of people involved. In 2008 and in past years there was about 650 to 700 people involved. In 2009 we saw growth with 1,016 people involved. In 2010 we saw even more growth with 1,289 people involved. 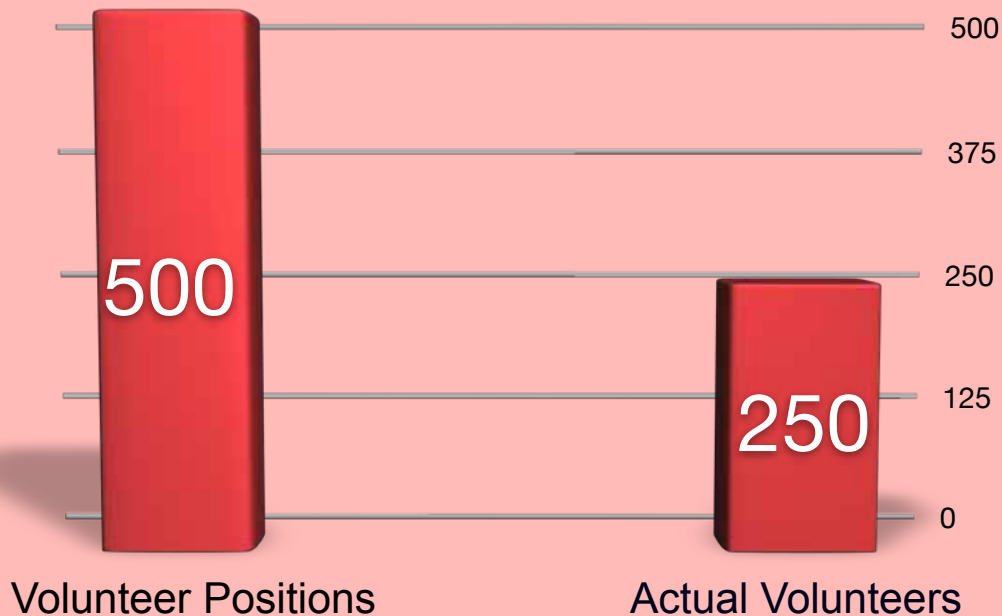

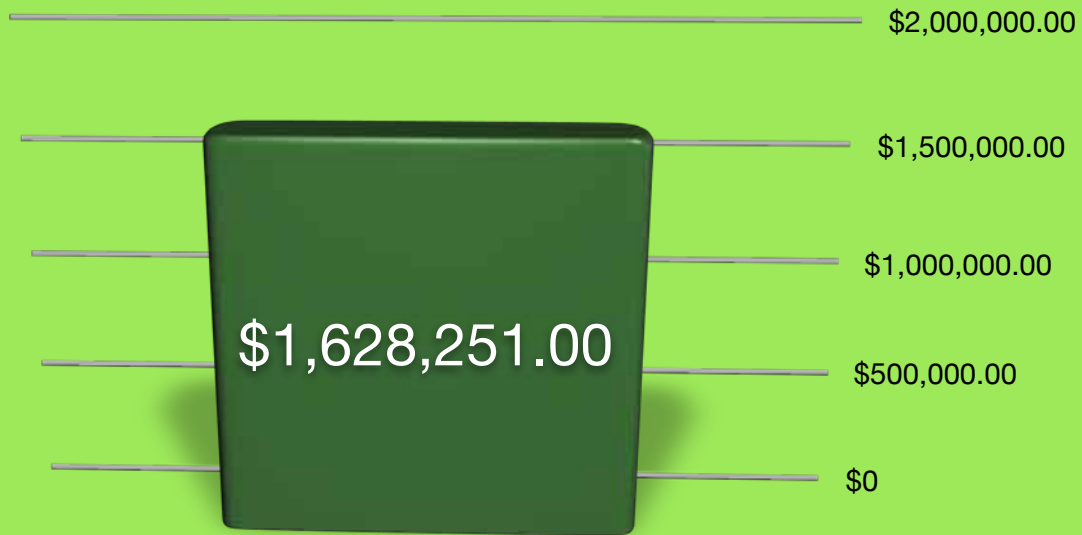




GIVING BREAKDOWN

(Total Income, Expenses, Tithes, Other Income, Life Academy)



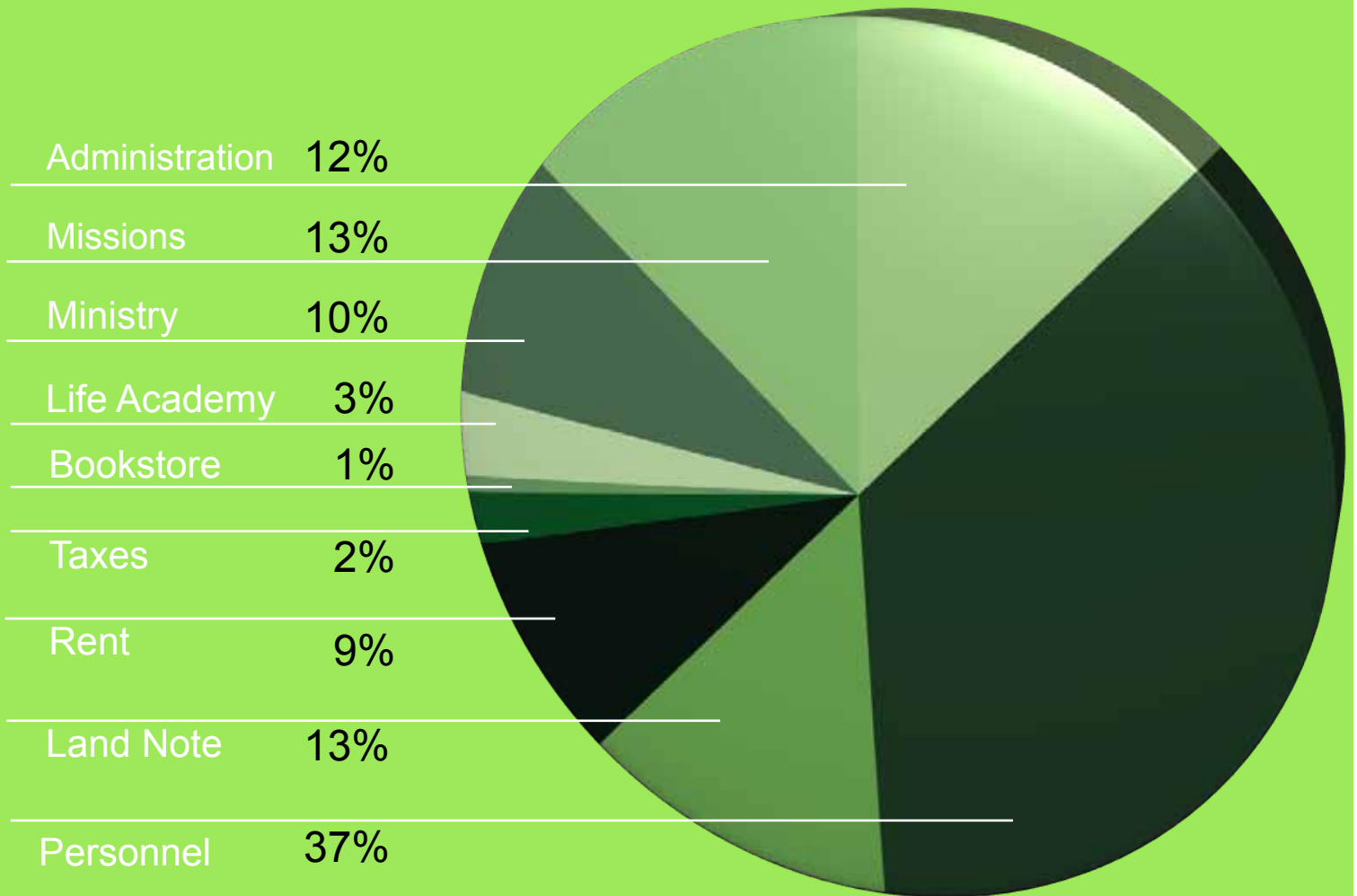

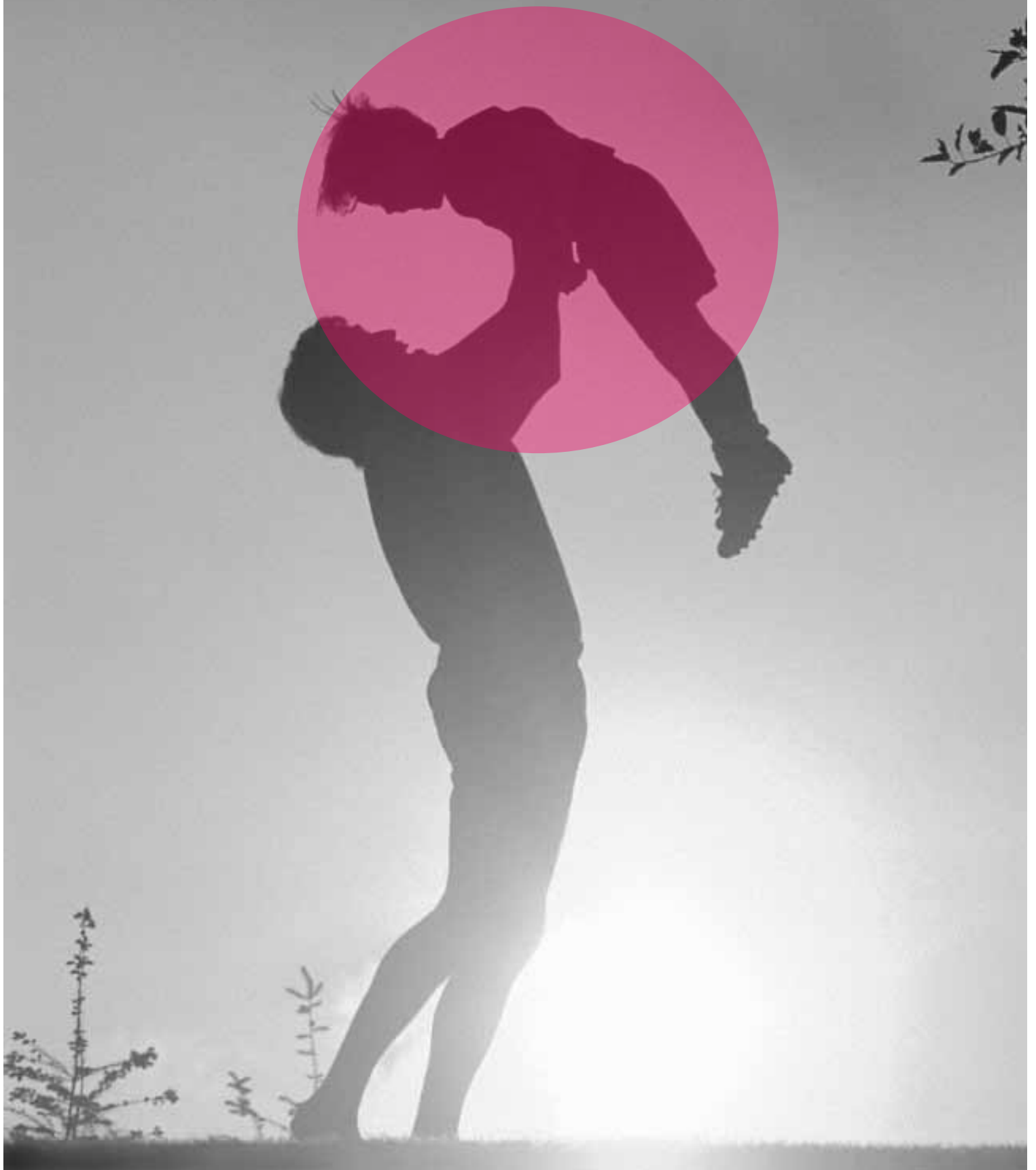
MISSION STATEMENT

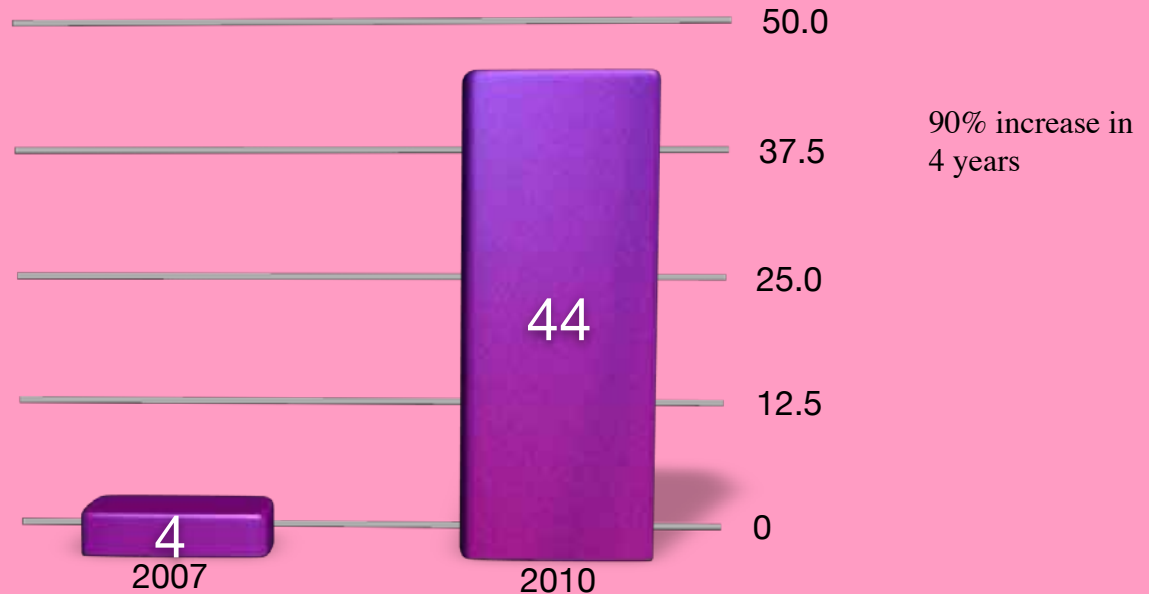
Prayer Building (Includes 2010 and 2011 offerings)

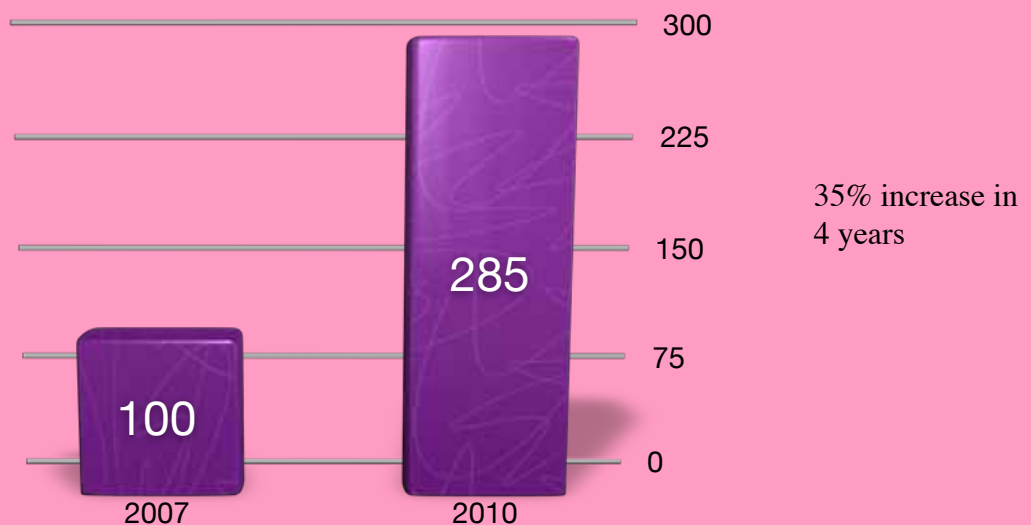
Foster Care Homes in Pearl River County



In 2010 we have seen a great response in answering the call of taking care of the orphans in our county. We have been serving DHS (department of human services) of Mississippi since 2007. In 2007 pearl river county had 4 foster homes and now in 2010 going into 2011 we have 44 foster homes. We have 9 couples in our church that are foster care parents, with 3 on the waiting list. Since we have been serving DHS, we have seen a relationship grow with the state to where we are the main location for their foster care classes and for help with recruiting families for them. We love

In 2010 we hosted two foster care classes with 105 people attended.

In 2010 we had our annual foster care Christmas party with 285 people (foster children/foster families) that attended.

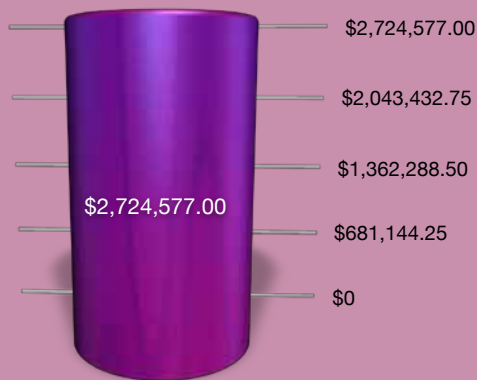

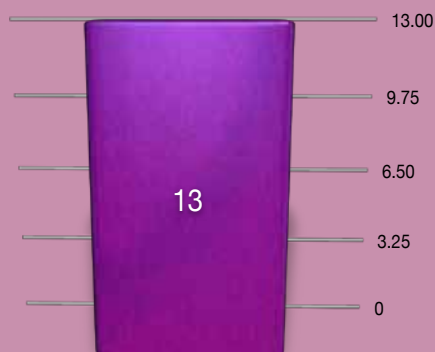
